the Proceedings of the Benevolent
Society of the 1st Presbyterian
Church of Coanbury.

Coanbury Nov 7th 1840.

A number of females of the 1st Presbyterian church
& congregation of Coanbury met in the Sepins
House this day, to reorganize the Female
Benevolent Society that existed for several years
previous to the division of the congregation.

The meeting being opened with prayer by the
Rev. L. C. Henry, agreed upon adopting the following
articles as their constitution.

1 This society shall be known by the name of
the Female Benevolent Society of the 1st Presbyterian
congregation of Coanbury.

2 The business of this society shall be conducted
by a Board of twenty eight managers
annually chosen, seven of whom shall constitute
a quorum to do business.

3 The officers of this society shall be a President three Vice Presidents, Secretary and Treasurer, all of whom shall be chosen from the Board of Managers.

4 There shall be an annual meeting of the society on the first Monday of November each year and the board of managers shall meet as often as shall be deemed necessary.

5 The payment of fifty cents a year will constitute a person a member of this society.

6 The objects of this society shall be to aid the funds of the Missionary and Education Societies of the Presbytery and aid in general to relieve the indigent and suppress at the discretion of the Managers.
