Mutual duties of vacant churches and moderators appointed to preside over them, as defined by the presbytery at its meeting at Cranbury, N. J., April 10, 1895.

Vacant Churches.

1. As soon as a church becomes vacant the elders should put themselves, without any delay, in communication with the moderator appointed by the presbytery, that he may convene them for the purpose of taking the necessary steps for the supply of the pulpit, if presbytery has committed that privilege to them.
2. No meeting of session should be called for the transaction of business without the direction or presence of the moderator.
3. The invitations to ministers to preach in the vacant pulpit should be given, in every case, by the moderator, as the official representative and mouthpiece of the session.
4. The session may not invite a minister to act as stated supply of the vacant church, who is not a member of our presbytery, until his credentials have been approved by the presbytery's committee on the subject.
5. **RULE 34.**—In the event of an aid-receiving church becoming vacant, the committee shall take immediate charge of the pulpit, and put, at the earliest practicable moment, a stated supply upon the field, whose salary shall be determined by mutual agreement between the church, or station, and the committee.
6. **RULE 37.**—Whenever a congregation, not receiving aid, becomes vacant, it shall be the duty of the moderator of its session, by and with the consent of that body, to secure and send the supplies for the pulpit, and unless, or until the presbytery appoints a moderator for the session, the chairman of the Committee of Supplies shall be the moderator of the session of the vacant congregation.
7. **RULE 39.**—When a minister is appointed moderator of a vacant church, his expenses shall be paid by said church; compensation shall also be given to a minister called to preside at a congregational meeting for calling a pastor.

Moderators of Sessions of Vacant Churches.

1. The moderator appointed by presbytery is the convener of the session of the vacant church, and is expected at the earliest practicable moment to call the session together in order to take measures for the supply of the pulpit, and that he may act as the medium of communication between the presbytery and the vacant church, and afford all the counsel, encouragement and help that may be required.
2. The moderator is expected to watch with scrupulous care over the matter of supplies for the pulpit and candidates for the pastorate, and, as the agent of the session, to issue all invitations to those who are needed for these purposes.
3. The moderator may not, unless in extraordinary cases, authorize the session to act without him, or delegate his powers to another minister, and in no case to one not a member of our presbytery.
